Dear Sir/ Madam:

I had actually sent respective policy suggestions severally to the various bureaus & departments of HK Govt. before, while disappointedly I faced NO response afterward! ",,, Anyway, for the great trouble severe shortage of columbarium's supply domestically, 4 respective policy to alleviate it I do propose:

- 1) On venue for constructing NEW columbaria building, I do recommend that be the 1st choice at inner site of Industrial zone, where the columbaria can be surrounded, & "sheltered" from the industrial buildings beside, to reduce any unnecessary nuisance to residential people nearby! ----- Comparatively, the venue at rural residential area ought to be LESS ideal, as it still exists so many residents who will have to long-term face these nuisances!
- I absolutely deem, <u>impossible for unlimited increase</u> for the quantity of public columbarium! So, I definitely agree introduction of institution of "RECYCLING of public columbarium-niche space" on at least, such as 20 years! Under this statuary restriction, it can be anticipated the domestic amount of urn-shrine columbarium will be under the controllable maintenance.
- 3) It ought to encourage implementation of the policy of <u>FREE pour of cremated-ash to sea</u> for such "voluntary" abstain for request of long-term space-occupation for ancestor's urn-shrine niche afterward!
- 4) Similar to item 3, the Govt. ought to proactively propose institution of "Cyber-niche" which, FREE website can be offered individually for memorization of those dead persons.
