## **Small Volume Exemption**

\* Pre-packaged food products with annual sales volume not exceeding 30,000 units – may be granted by the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) with exemption from all the legal requirements under the Nutrition Labelling Scheme





## Small Volume Exemption

- Provided that the nutrition information included on the label is true and not misleading, exemption can still be granted.
- If any <u>nutrition claim</u> is made, exemption status will be removed.





## Small Volume Exemption

- Exemption is product-specific (i.e. does not cover other products sold by the permission holder) and trader-specific (i.e. does not cover the same product sold by non-permission holders).
- Products of different packing sizes/ flavours are considered as different food products.





#### Web-based system

- Single platform for information and monitoring
  - For the CFS to monitor and track exempted products
  - For the permission holders to have access to the sales volume of the exempted products
  - For the general public to know which products are exempted





## Web-based system

- E-alert to the CFS and the permission holders when the product
  - Approaching exemption limit
  - Exceeding exemption limit





# Application for Exemption

- Eligible parties -
  - **Importers** (for imported products)
  - **Manufacturers** (for local products)
- Means of application
  - through web-site
  - in writing (by post, by fax or in person)





## **Application for Exemption**

The applicant should submit the details about the food product including:

- brand name,
- product description,
- country of origin,
- manufacturer's particulars,
- list of distribution (i.e. names and addresses of the distributors/retailers),
- label and pictures of product; and
- bar code (if available).





# **Application for Exemption**

- If the product under application already granted with exemption, the applicant will be notified of the sales volume already reached in the current validity period of exemption.
- \* The applicant can still apply but the exemption, if granted, will only be valid (a) until the expiry date of the exemption first granted to the same product; or (b) until the exemption limit is reached, whichever is the earlier.





# Application for Exemption

- Upon granting of exemption, a permission letter with the permission number for the product will be issued to the applicant.
- The effective dates of all permissions will fall on the first day of a month following the month in which the respective permission has been granted.





# Fee for Exemption

- An annual permission fee will be charged on a full cost recovery basis
- Non-refundable even if the permission is revoked by the CFS, or voluntarily cancelled by the permission holder





#### **Conditions for Exemption**

 The permission for exemption will be granted subject to the observance of the conditions imposed by the CFS





## **Conditions for Exemption**

a) The permission holder should notify the CFS of any changes to the names and addresses of the distributors/retailers.





#### **Conditions for Exemption**

b) The permission holder should keep for at least two years from the date of granting exemption an accurate and upto-date record of distribution in respect of the exempted product.

Such record shall be made available for inspection upon request by the CFS.





# **Conditions for Exemption**

c) The permission holder should report to the CFS the <u>sales volume</u> in respect of the exempted product on <u>monthly</u> basis (within the first 10 days of each calendar month).





## **Conditions for Exemption**

d) The permission holder should submit an annual report to the CFS certified by a registered auditor or accountant on the total sales volume in respect of the exempted product in the past year (within 14 days after expiry of the permission or alternatively, after the completion of the annual accounting assessment/statement by the permission holder's company)





## Revocation of Exemption

- If any condition is breached, CFS would issue a warning letter to the permission holder for rectification within 7 days.
- If the warning is unheeded to, the permission would be revoked or not renewed.





# Revocation of Exemption

If the permission is revoked due to breach of any of the conditions, no exemption will be granted to the same permission holder in respect of the <u>same</u> product within a period of two years.





## **Exemption Limit**

- Over
  - When the 30,000 unit exemption limit is exceeded, the exemption would be revoked.
  - No exemption will be granted for the product within a period of two years.





## **Exemption Limit**

- Within
  - If the exemption limit is not exceeded at the end of one year, the permission may be renewed for the following year
  - The sales volume for the product recorded in the website will be reset to zero
  - All the permission holders are required to pay the annual renewal fee





# Label for Exempted Product

- The exempted product, when displayed for sale, should be marked with a specific label/sticker indicating the exemption status.
- The <u>permission number</u> should also be marked on either the label/sticker or the shelf where the exempted product is displayed for sale.





## Label for Exempted Product

• It will be an offence for the retailer if it sells any exempted products which are not marked with the specific label/sticker or the permission number.
